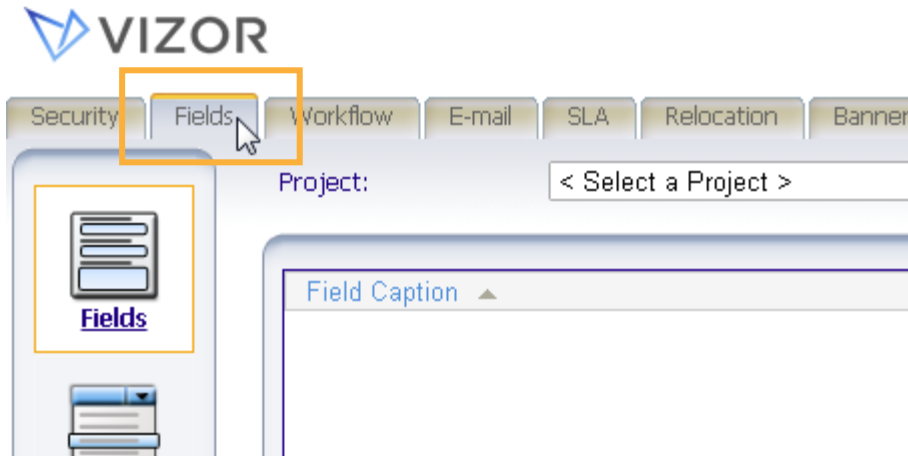


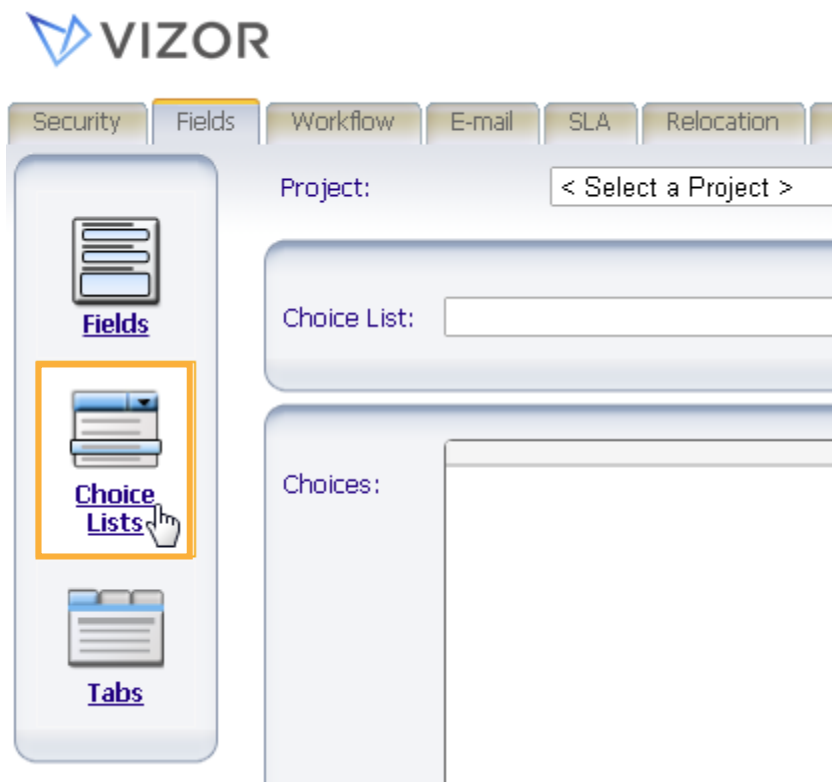
Edit Items from List

1. It is required to have VIZOR administration privileges to manage users. To login, go to <https://YOURSERVER/connectadmin/>

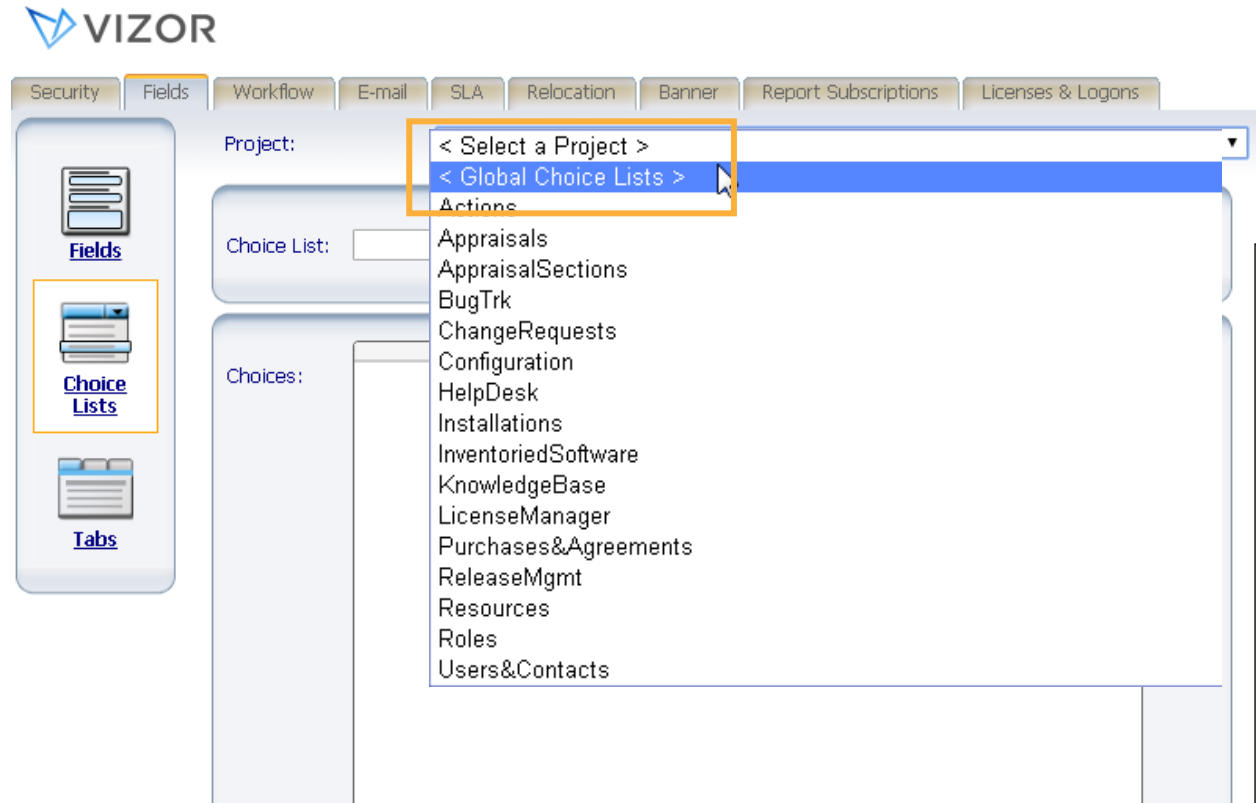
2. Select the Fields tab



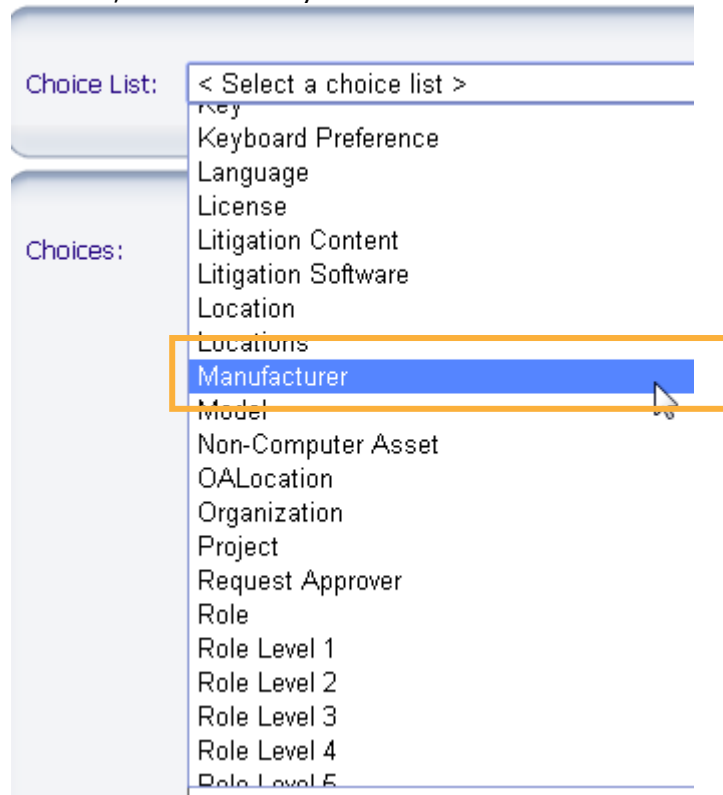
3. Click on Choice Lists



4. Change <Select a Project>to <Select a Choice List>



5. Then, click the list you want to edit



6. Use the buttons on the right side to edit the list. Either Add, Update or remove.

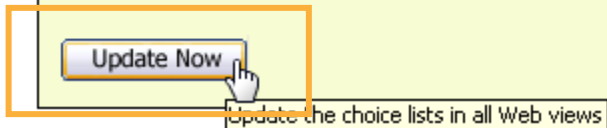

Note: Automatically updating a large number of choice lists may affect performance. You should automatically update only the choice lists that you plan to frequently change.

If you make a change to a choice list that has visual cues in the summary list, you will need to regenerate all Web views where the choice list is used.
